



Enclosed please find an original and two copies of the revised tariff pages to be filed with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("ICC") for the Illinois Small Company Exchange Carrier Association (ISCECA) Illinois C.C. No. 1.

This filing is being made in compliance with the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") June 5, 2012 Order in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc., FCC Release No. DA 12-870 ("FCC Order"), Intercarrier Compensation rule changes that become effective on July 3, 2012. In compliance with the FCC Order, this filing proposes to make an overall revenue reduction to intrastate Switched Access by bringing intrastate Switched Access rates into parity with interstate Switched Access rates for each rate element. This filing also changes the rate structure to reflect both Originating and Terminating rates for each rate element.

(d) Intercept

The Intercept function provides for the termination of a call at a Telephone Company Intercept operator or recording. The operator or recording tells a caller why a call, as dialed, could not be completed, and if possible, provides the correct number.

(2) Transitional Rate Element

The Transitional Rate Element is a rate authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to recover the difference in access revenue from applying the previous intrastate rates and rate elements and applying the interstate rates and rate structures to the F.C.C. designated Fiscal Year volumes. The terminating Transitional Rate Element recovers half of the difference in access revenue from applying the previous rate and rate elements and applying the interstate rates and rate structure. The originating Transitional Rate Element recovers the difference in access revenue from applying the previous rates and rate elements and applying the interstate rates and rate structure.

(3) Information Surcharge

Information Surcharge rates are assessed to a customer based on the total number of access minutes. Information Surcharge rates are as set forth in 17.2.3(B) following. The application of these rates with respect to individual Feature Groups is as set forth in 6.4.1(C) following.

The Information Surcharge does not apply to Feature Groups B and D Switched Access Services associated with Wireless Switching Center (WSCs) directly interconnected to a Telephone Company access tandem office.

13.3 Miscellaneous Services (Cont'd)

13.3.2 Maintenance of Service

- (A) When a customer reports a trouble to the Telephone Company for clearance and no trouble is found in the Telephone Company's facilities, the customer shall be responsible for payment of a Maintenance of Service charge as set forth in 17.4.4(F) following, for the period of time from when the Telephone Company personnel are dispatched at the request of the customer, to the customer designated premises to when the work is completed. Failure of the Telephone Company personnel to find trouble in Telephone Company facilities will result in no charge if the trouble is actually in those facilities, but not discovered at the time.
- (B) The customer shall be responsible for payment of a Maintenance of Service charge when the Telephone Company dispatches personnel to the customer designated premises, and the trouble is in equipment or communications systems provided by other than the Telephone Company or in detariffed CPE provided by the Telephone Company.

In either (A) or (B) preceding, no credit allowance will be applicable for the interruption involved if the Maintenance of Service Charge applies.

(C) Programming Services

Programming charges apply when a request by a customer for information concerning the access services provided to the customer result in the creation of new computer software or the modification of existing software in order to provide the requested information.

The Telephone Company will notify the customer that additional programming charges will apply before any additional programming is undertaken.

13.3.3 Telecommunications Service Priority - TSP

- (A) Priority installation and/or restoration of National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) telecommunications services shall be provided in accordance with Part 64.401, Appendix A, of the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Rules and Regulations.

In addition, TSP system service shall be provided in accordance with the guidelines set forth in "Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) System for National Security Emergency Preparedness (NSEP) Service Vendor Handbook" (NCSH 3-2-1) dated July 9, 1990, and "Telecommunications Service Priority System for National Security Emergency Preparedness Service User Manual" (NCSM 3-1-1).

13.7 Originating Line Screening (OLS) Service

The Telephone Company will provide OLS Service to aggregators and other customers who obtain local exchange service from the Telephone Company under its general or local exchange tariff. OLS service enables customers to determine whether there are billing restrictions on exchange service lines from which a call originates. OLS service delivers codes on operator assisted calls made from aggregator locations to identify, calls originating from privately owned payphones, inmate locations, and hotels/motels, etc.

OLS Service is provided at no charge when ordered with the installation of new local exchange service. However, when an OLS code is added to an existing exchange service line, a charge is applied as set forth in 17.4.4(L). This charge is applied for each exchange service line to which an OLS code is assigned. The customer must specify the number of exchange service lines on each individual telephone number equipped.

A Miscellaneous Service Order Charge as set for in 17.4.1(D) will apply to orders adding OLS codes that are placed subsequent to the initial installation of the associated exchange service line.

This charge does not apply when OLS codes are removed from an exchange service line at the same time that the exchange service line is disconnected.

OLS codes may be delivered using Line Information Database (LIDB) or Flexible Automatic Number Identification (Flex ANI) technology. Those telephone companies delivering OLS codes using LIDB are identified in NATIONAL EXCHANGE CARRIER ASSOCIATION, INC. TARIFF F.C.C. NO. 4, as are those companies delivering OLS codes using Flex ANI.

13.8 Blocking Services

Central office blocking service is offered only where technically feasible.

(A) 900 Blocking Service

900 Service Access Restriction prevents access to the 900 network. When customers dial a 0+ or 1+ 900 pay-per-call number from a restricted telephone number, the 900 call is blocked.

Charges associated with 900 Service Access Restriction will be waived for customers who request a new line for a period of 60 days after the new line is installed.

Requests by customers to remove 900 Service Access Restriction must be submitted in writing to the Telephone Company.

13.9 Nonchargeable Confirmation Services

13.9.1 Billed Number Screening (BNS)

At the request of the customer, the Telephone Company business office will confirm BNS codes associated with a line to which a call is to be billed.

13.9.2 Originating Line Screening (OLS)

At the request of the customer, the Telephone Company business office will confirm OLS codes associated with an exchange service line from which a call originates.

13.10 Payphone-Specific Coding Digits Service

The Telephone Company will equip local exchange pay telephone lines ordered by Payphone Service Providers (PSPs) from the Telephone Company's general and/or local exchange tariff with the capability to transmit payphone-specific coding digits (e.g., 27 for pay telephones requiring central office coin supervision, 29 for prison/inmate pay telephones, and 70 for pay telephones not requiring central office coin supervision) to the Interexchange Carrier. These digits will be transmitted via Flexible Automatic Number Identification (Flex ANI) to Interexchange Carriers who have trunks equipped with the Flex ANI optional feature as described in Section 6 preceding. The Interexchange Carriers will use this information to compensate the PSPs for subscriber 800 series calls and dial-around access code calls (e.g., 101XXXX) placed from pay telephones.

The Telephone Company will apply a monthly Payphone-Specific Coding Digits Service charge, as set forth in 17.4.4(M) following, to each pay telephone service line that is assigned a payphone-specific coding digit. This charge recovers the initial costs of deploying the Flex ANI capability and will be in effect for the period September 1, 1998 through August 31, 2001.
